<p><b>1. What Needs to Change?</b>  <i>Describe the problem and what needs to be done to improve the situation.</i></p> <p>The problem is lack of secured funding to ensure that the proposed development goes ahead. Funding needs to be secured.</p>	
<p><b>2. What tasks need to be done?</b>  <i>List, step by step, the activities that need to be done, in order to improve the situation</i></p> <p>We need to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Raise awareness of the project and develop local support.</li> <li>* Identify groups that should be involved, both from the point of view of raising awareness but also those groups who would benefit from the proposed development.</li> <li>* Ensure that the plan includes appropriate sporting and recreational activities.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>3. Who will do them?</b>  <i>State who will do what (or have responsibility for getting a task done) and when by e.g. end May or by 5 Jan 2006.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* CW will contact Challoner Chute asking what support he needs, who we need to write to and when. We will also suggest that he presents the scheme and need for funding to NWDC Area 2 Committee and WCC.</li> <li>* The Theme Group should write to both local MPs looking for support for the Scheme.</li> <li>* The Theme Group will develop a detailed action plan.</li> </ul>	<p><b>When by?</b></p> <p>10 Nov 2005</p> <p>TBA</p> <p>TBA</p>
<p><b>4. What else do we need?</b>  <i>Does a meeting need to be organised, or a questionnaire or some letters written, some photocopying perhaps – itemise and cost</i></p> <p>We need a meeting of the Theme Group, possibly with Challoner Chute present to agree next steps / action plan.</p>	<p><b>Costs?</b></p> <p>Costs likely to be low – absorbed by Cricklade Town Council?</p>
<p><b>5. Who else needs to be involved?</b>  <i>Indicate who else needs to be involved – a parish or county councillor, the police, etc.</i></p> <p>Both MPs; NWDC; WCC; Cricklade Town Council; Cricklade &amp; Swindon Railway; Schools/education establishments; Ramblers Association; SUSTRANS; Rights of Way Authority.</p>	<p><b>In what way?</b>  <i>What do we want these “stakeholders” to do</i></p> <p>To provide unqualified support for the Scheme, which will assist in raising the necessary funding.</p>
<p><b>6. How will we know if things are better?</b>  <i>Lastly, how will we know things have improved? What are our indicators?</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* The level of support for the proposed Scheme has increased – we may need to demonstrate this with before and after surveys organised by NCAP.</li> <li>* The amount of funding actually raised/promised will have increased.</li> </ul>
